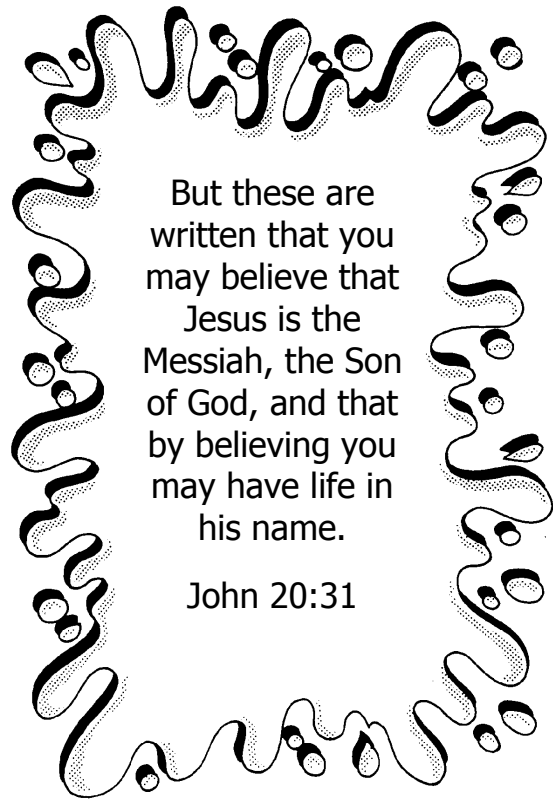

The First Commandment

The Lord bless you and keep you; the Lord make His face shine upon you and be gracious to you; the Lord turn His face toward you and give you peace. Numbers 6:24-26

The Third Commandment

The Fifth Commandment

You shall not Murder.

This means we should fear and love God so that we do not hurt or harm our neighbor in his body, but help and support him in every physical need.

All who draw the sword will die by the
sword. Matthew 26:52

Out of the heart come evil thoughts, mur-
der, adultery, sexual immorality, theft,
false testimony, slander. Matthew 15:19

Your eyes saw my unformed body. All the
days ordained for me were written in
Your book before one of them came to
be. Psalm 139:16

Blessed are the meek, for they will inherit
the earth. Blessed are the merciful, for
they will be shown mercy. Blessed are the
peacemakers, for they will be called sons
of God. Matthew 5:5, 7, 9

his brother will be subject to judgment.

The Sixth Commandment

You shall not commit adultery.

This means we should fear and love God so that we lead a sexually pure and decent life in what we say do, and husband and wife love and honor each other.

God created man in His own image, in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. ... God saw all that He made, and it was very good.

Genesis 1:27, 31

For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and they will become one flesh. Genesis 2:24

I tell you that anyone who looks at a woman lustfully has already committed adultery with her in his heart. Matthew 5:28

How then could I do such a wicked thing and sin against God? Genesis 39:9

Flee from sexual immorality. All other sins a man commits are outside his body, but he who sins sexually sins against his own body. 1 Corinthians 6:18

The Seventh Commandment

You shall not steal.

This means we should fear and love God so that we do not take our neighbor's money or possessions, or get them in any dishonest way, but help him to improve and protect his possessions and income.

He who has been stealing must steal no longer, but must work, doing something useful with his own hands, that he may have something to share with those in need. Ephesians 4:28

Give to one who asks you, and do not turn away from the one who wants to borrow from you. Matthew 5:42

In everything, do to others what you would have them do to you. Matthew 7:12

The Eighth Commandment

You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.

This means we should fear and love God so that we do not tell lies about our neighbor, betray him, slander him, or hurt his reputation, but defend him, speak well of him, and explain everything in the kindest way.

A false witness will not go unpunished, and he who pours out lies will not go free. Proverbs 19:5

[Love] always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres. 1 Corinthians 13:7

If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. Matthew 18:15

The Ninth Commandment

You shall not covet your neighbor's house.

This means we should love and fear God so that we do not scheme to get our neighbor's inheritance or house, or get it in a way which only appears right, but help and be of service to him in keeping it.

Sin... produced in me every kind of covetous desire. Romans 7:8

The Tenth Commandment

You shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or his manservant or maidservant, his ox or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor.

This means that we should fear and love God so that we do not entice or force away our neighbor's wife, workers, or animals, or turn them against him, but urge them to stay and do their duty.

He said to them, "Watch out! Be on your guard against all kinds of greed; a man's life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions." Luke 12:15

Direct me in the path of Your commands, for there I find delight. Turn my heart toward Your statutes and not toward selfish gain. Psalm 119:35-36

The Close of the Commandments
